Reminder about your responsibilities as a horse owner as required by current EU regulation:

- You are required to register a foal within 6 months of birth or before 31st December of the year of birth.
- A new owner is required to notify the PIO of a change of ownership within 30 days of purchasing the horse.
- If you have imported a horse into the country you are required to register the horse within 30 days of import (this includes horses that have an existing passport that are imported from EU countries).
- The death of a horse should be reported within 30 days and the passport returned to STAGBI within 30 days.

NOTICES

- ❖ **Replacement Microchips:** Please be reminded that in the event that it is not possible to locate a previously implanted microchip, you are required to contact STAGBI for a replacement microchip.

It is imperative that an alternative scanner is used to confirm that the microchip cannot be located and that the whole neck region (both sides) are searched. Whilst microchips are usually implanted in the mid crest region of the left side of the neck, they can migrate to the poll and shoulder region.

Should it be necessary to implant a replacement microchip, the vet needs to complete Replacement Microchip Form - confirming the identification of the horse; documenting new microchip details and obtaining a repeat DNA sample. The completed form, DNA sample and passport should be returned to STAGBI. In accordance with EU & DEFRA regulations, implanting a replacement microchip will result in the horse being excluded from the Human Food Chain. Both microchip numbers will be recorded in the passport and STAGBI database.

- ❖ **Reminder to MARE OWNERS:** Please remember that Foals born in 2016 should be registered by 31 Dec 2016. Late registrations will cost you more money, so please get your registrations in on time. Foal registration packs are obtained by sending your FOALING RETURN (smaller section attached to the mating certificate) to STAGBI Office with £10 fee.
- ❖ **Reminder to STALLION OWNERS:** All stallion owners should have received Application for Mating Certificates forms from the STAGBI Office. Please ensure that the forms are completed in full and returned to STAGBI OFFICE by 31 Dec. Mating certificates are issued at £10 per

mare, whereas retrospective/late mating certificates cost £50 per mare.

- ❖ **Notice to Stallion Owners:** As from January 1st 2016, stallion owners are required to submit an application for a Stallion Licence **BEFORE** covering any mares. Issuing a Stallion Licence is subject to the approval of STAGBI; covering mares before a Stallion Licence is issued is done so at the stallion owner's own risk as the application for a Stallion Licence may be unsuccessful.

- ❖ **Registrations of Standardbreds in Ireland:**

As many of you may now be aware, the Irish Harness Racing Association have chosen to become independent of STAGBI. The IHRA will manage the Irish Standardbred Stud Book and have been issued Passport Issuing Organisation status with registrations and passports being processed and issued by Horse Sport Ireland. As of 1st Feb 2016, the IHRA now request that all Standardbreds in Ireland are registered with the IHRA. Enquiries regarding new registrations should be directed to the IHRA 01 5310365 or info@irishharnessracing.com.

All current STAGBI passports issued to horses in Ireland are valid. However, the IHRA request that all Standardbreds in Ireland are transferred from the STAGBI Stud Book / Database and into the new Irish Standardbred Stud Book / Database. In order to achieve this, Irish owners are required to submit a completed **Application to Transfer Form**, for each horse to STAGBI. For Irish members, an application form can be found on the reverse of the address label of this newsletter. Please photocopy if you require further copies or forms can be downloaded from STAGBI or IHRC websites. Complete the form and **return to STAGBI with appropriate fee (£50)**. Stallions transferred prior to 1st May 2016, will be done free of charge (£50 thereafter). Broodmares transferred prior to 31st Oct 2016, will be done free of charge (£50 thereafter).

Prior to transfer please ensure that the horse is currently registered in your name and that you are in possession of a valid passport.

- If you have not already transferred the horse into your name then you need to do so before horse can be exported from STAGBI to IHRA.
- If you require a duplicate passport, you will need to apply to STAGBI for a duplicate passport.
- If you are processing a new registration, please note that the dam of the foal has to be transferred from STAGBI to IHRA before the registration can be processed by IHRA.

Once a horse is exported from STAGBI to IHRA then any future transactions should be pursued with the IHRA. Stallions transferred from STAGBI to IHRA will be removed from

STAGBI Stallion List and applications for future mating certs should be made to the IHRA. However, applications for retrospective mating certificates should be made to STAGBI. STAGBI and IHRA have agreed to honour mating certificates issued by either organisation regardless.

Due to increase in postage fees March 2016, please note increased postage for Ireland. Any passport posted to Ireland (Signed and tracked) will incur additional £10 fee, all other transactions incur £5 postage

If anybody in Ireland would like to continue to receive STAGBI Newsletter, please renew membership £20 per year (£10 per year & £10 Postage)

Le Trot so far... a good start

It is just over two years since Le Trot signed agreements with STAGBI, as the breed society, and TROTBritain, as the racing organisation, to facilitate the breeding and racing of TROTTEUR Francais in Great Britain.

We are now half way through the third year of the massive transformation of the trotting scene that has resulted. 21 Le Trot races have been run so far this year, on 10 different tracks spread across our three countries, for total prizemoney of just over £50,000, or an average of £2,500 a race. We are therefore on schedule for a significant increase in the number of races and prizemoney in 2015 (31 and £70,000).

While there has therefore been a staggering change from where trotting was in 2013, we are still held back from realising the full potential of the French support by a shortage of horses - or rather buyers. This shortage prevents us from running the 3 or 4 races per meeting which would make the fields more equal in quality, compared with the situation where there are only two on the card. We are committed to avoiding the multiple trails that would be the conventional solution since, with mobile starts, this has no future in off track betting.

In conjunction with Le Trot we have organised 3 Sales which have brought in 28, 19 and 13 horses respectively, 42 geldings and 19 mares. The Sales have been on a lottery basis, as this is the only way we can guarantee a sizeable number of horses being acquired at a time. The method has its downside for those who are used to choosing their horse. The upside is that the challenge of finding, buying, and importing a horse of the equivalent quality to those we have selected at €2500 euros, is considerable.

The private route is attractive to those who fancy their ability to judge a horse (and more important, judge its connections!) which is why we continue to provide it, subject to a cap on the horse's earnings in order to produce competitive racing here. The Irish have

made the lottery sale the only route and have managed to acquire lots more horses than we have. (Multiple explanations are offered for the difference between the two situations and I leave the reader to speculate.) The IHRA commitment to the UET move to an 80/20 trotting/pacing split by 2018 may be part of the explanation.

Selection in these Sales has been a learning experience. We are delighted to have been able to bring horses like ROBEC, VERY CORNUAILLAISE, SHOW BUSINESS, SULKY DU BLEQUIN and TENOR MESLOIS before the British public, to name just five. However, only just over half of the earlier imports have raced in 2016, despite their passing our qualification test and some vetting. We need to be realistic about the reasons. Some older horses did have problems that were manageable in France by those familiar with the horses idiosyncracies in terms of bit, harness and shoeing. And familiar with trotters in general because trotters are not pacers and require a major change of mindset. Getting a French trotter to trot is never easy, but happily we can see many of our supporters are moving up the steep learning curve.

On the breeding side, three of the original mares have now been sent back to France and are in foal to Reach de Vandel, a well-performed son of Look de Star by Cocktail Jet, with a 1.11.1 record. While there is clearly considerable interest in breeding and importing young horses, the problem, as with the older horses, is generating the minimal critical mass to warrant a series, even for 3yos in 2020. Rushing TFs as 2yo is not a good idea, so we will not be building it into our plans. Collaborating with the Irish is an obvious possibility to be explored.

It would be good to bring in another 20 horses in our next Sale to supply the demand for LE Trot races, especially if the forthcoming trial races at Chelmsford are successful and that becomes a significant part of our 2017 scene. For more information contact Jack Dowie on trotbritain@gmail.com.

NEW REGISTRATIONS MAR 16 to JUL 16

Please note that when new registrations are received the passport is issued SUBJECT TO PARENTAL VERIFICATION (see notes page within equine passport). Should there be a subsequent issue with the DNA result or the Parental Verification has not been confirmed, then STAGBI will recall the passport

and suspend the registration until such time as the matter has been resolved.

In the case of Late Registrations (Registrations received after the year of birth), passports will not be issued until such time as Parental Verification by DNA has been confirmed. Please be aware that this can take up to 6 to 8 weeks.
