❖ GUIDELINES IF YOU ARE BUYING HORSES FROM IRELAND and the need for AN EXPORT CERTIFICATE

In January 2016, the IHRA opted to become independent of STAGBI and now register Standardbreds in Ireland via Sports Horse Ireland.

Furthermore the IHRA have stipulated that, all standardbred horses in Ireland that are registered with STAGBI are exported from STAGBI to IHRA. The process has been repeatedly outlined in previous newsletters/website/social media etc. To date over 600 horses have been exported from STAGBI Studbook/Database to the IHRA Studbook/Database.

Now we need to inform British owners what they need to do if you buy a horse from Ireland. In essence, the horse needs to be exported from the IHRA Studbook & Database into the STAGBI Studbook & Database. Please note, if you are purchasing a horse to race, currently the complete process may take 2 weeks or more.

There are a few different scenarios:

- 1. If a British buyer purchases a STAGBI registered horse that has already been exported to IHRA (ie holds a STAGBI passport that has been overstamped by IHRA).**

This horse will have been removed from STAGBI database, so needs to be re-instated with STAGBI. You will need to **apply to the IHRA for an export certificate**. Currently as part of the export process, the IHRA require that the passport is submitted to IHRA office in Cork to process the transfer of ownership. Then you will need to **apply to STAGBI to register the horse with STAGBI**. The passport is again required for over-stamping by STAGBI. The IHRA application for export form and the application to re-register STAGBI form are available on STAGBI website or via STAGBI office.

- 2. If a British buyer purchases an IHRA registered horse (ie never registered with STAGBI and holds an IHRA passport)**

Process, exactly as above. Once horse is registered, breeding details etc will be included on STAGBI Breeding website.

Currently the IHRA Export Fee is €50 and the STAGBI registration fee is £50.

STAGBI office is here to assist you, but incomplete forms, unsigned forms, missing passports and/or non payments all delay the process.

- 3. If a British buyer purchases a horse from Ireland that has a STAGBI passport but has not been exported to IHRA**

British buyer should submit the transfer of ownership form to STAGBI as per usual.

If you re uncertain of the horse's status as regard STAGBI/IHRA, please contact STAGBI or IHRA for assistance on how to proceed.

❖ REGISTRATIONS

Reminder that foals born in 2017 should be registered by 31st December.

Please don't leave it to the last minute, you can get your STAGBI registration pack by returning your Foaling Return Slip (smaller section of the mating certificate) to the STAGBI office with £10 fee.

Registration fee is £45 but applications received after the 1st January will incur a higher registration fee £120.

❖ STALLION RETURNS

Now is the time to complete your Stallion return forms and submit to the STAGBI Office. If you haven't received your stallion returns, you can either contact the STAGBI office or download from the website www.standardbred.org and click on services. You need to apply for mating certificates in the year of covering.

Mating certificates are issued at £10 per mare, retrospective mating certificates cost £50 per mare.

NEW REGISTRATIONS Mar 17 – Aug 17

Please note that when new registrations are received the passport is issued SUBJECT TO PARENTAL VERIFICATION (see notes page within equine passport). Should there be a subsequent issue with the DNA result or the Parental Verification has not been confirmed, then STAGBI will recall the passport and suspend the registration until such time as the matter has been resolved.

In the case of Late Registrations (Registrations received after the year of birth), passports will not be issued until such time as Parental Verification by DNA has been confirmed. Please be aware that this can take up to 6 to 8 weeks.

Horse Passport Legislation: The current legislation relating to horse passports means it is a legal requirement for horses in Great Britain to be issued with a passport by an authorised Passport Issuing Organisation (PIO). It is the owner's responsibility to apply for a passport from an authorised PIO before the 31st of December of the year of birth or before the foal is 6 months old or whichever is the later.

Applications received by STAGBI after 31st December, will incur late registration fees. In accordance with Horse Passport Legislation, horses registered outside the permitted time scale will be stamped as "Not fit for Human Consumption"

Representatives from the BHRC and STAGBI have just returned from the International Trotting Associations (ITA) 25th World Trotting Conference (WTC) held this year in Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, Canada. The 2017 WTC was originally scheduled to be in Sweden, but following a request from Canada the destination was changed to Canada so as to coincide with the double anniversaries of 250 years of Horse Racing in Canada and 150 years of the Confederation of Canada.

Standardbred Canada took the decision to host the WTC on Prince Edward Island during 'Old Home Week' which culminates in the running of PEI's signature race, The Gold Cup and Saucer. This race is unique as post time is one minute to midnight amidst a huge gathering of passionate harness racing fans and a commentator that really gets the crowd going. If you ever get the opportunity to attend 'Old Home Week' and witness the 'Gold Cup & Saucer' then don't turn it down.

Standardbred Canada's theme for the conference was 'Investing for the future' and much discussion took place on where the sport/industry is heading rather than where it has been. This year there were delegates in attendance from Australia, Canada, Finland, France, GB, Ireland, New Zealand, Norway, Serbia, Sweden, USA and the UET. Each country attending is required to provide conference with their breeding and racing statistics. From a breeding perspective the almost universal fall in number of horse registers seen over the past decade appears to be plateaued. Whilst each country's size and scale of operation can be very different, many of the challenges faced are very similar. Key discussion points from each committee included:

Constitution & Regulation Committee: ITA membership categories; proposed classification of ITA countries; advance planning for future hosts of the WTC and World Driving Championship BHRC delegate Jim McNally highlighted GB's absence from recent WDCs and should be congratulated on his persistence and insistence in negotiating a possible pathway of invitation for British driver through a proposed change in selection process to be considered at next year's inter conference meeting in Sweden 2018.

Equine Health, Welfare & Integrity: International sharing of integrity intelligence; respect of penalty enforcement across ITA countries; sharing of international equine health and welfare statistics and recognizing the use of the whip as a welfare, rather than a performance, issue in the sport.

Racing & Wagering Committee: Advancing international growth of wagering markets for harness racing; addressing illegal wagering and ensuring/promoting good relationships with government, including maintaining and providing appropriate data about the industry's value.

Marketing & Business: Quantifying worldwide impact of harness racing; strengthening international communication, including social media; and comparative evaluation of horses and drivers worldwide.

Breeding Committee: From the STAGBI perspective the Breeding committee was the most pertinent. Following lengthy discussions, recommendations from the breeding committee included:

- With the increase in the number of horses travelling internationally there needs to be streamlining of the transfer of information from one country to another. An international agreement should and will be developed outlining the rules to data exchange. The first step will be to develop an

international portal for the collection and dissemination of data. This project will be chaired by Andrew Kelly, Australia.

- Currently there is a fragmented approach to the research relating to the equine Standardbred. The sharing of genomic testing protocol is necessary
- If any horse has been exported into a country and the need to alter/change name of said horse, the country of origin shall be notified of such.
- The location of the microchip shall be indicated on all registration documents. For example, Nuchal vs Nasal implant site (note: *Within the EU, the required site of implantation of a microchip is the region of the nuchal ligament of the neck. Both Southern hemisphere and North America are currently considering the introduction of microchipping. Southern Hemisphere propose to adopt the neck as the site of implantation but North America are looking to adopt an alternative site whereby the microchip will be implanted within the inner upper lip.*

Many of the topics raised and discussed in the committee were further explored in the 2 day symposium held within the conference. The symposium included 38 invited international speakers bringing a wealth of expertise, experience and knowledge to assist in addressing various issues within harness racing and including marketing, wagering, simulcasting, breeding and the use (or possibly more appropriately the mis-use) of the whip.

The International Media Awards were presented at the Closing ceremony. Congratulations to STAGBI Director and Vice President Sarah Thomas, Sarah's Blog page was nominated and short listed for Best Social Media Award. S4Cs RASUS Tregaron was also short listed for Best TV Programme. No awards this year but having been shortlisted both gained international recognition.

The welcome from Standardbred Canada was fantastic and made the WTC a very sociable and informative event. The participation, the sharing of information, networking with and seeking advice from other international representatives will hopefully benefit the breed and the sport here in the Great Britain.

The BREEDERS PREMIUM are awarded to the breeders of STAGBI registered British Bred (conceived and born in England, Scotland or Wales) horses from England, Scotland and Wales, and is based on the number of races won in that year. The Premiums are awarded at the end of the year.

The BREEDERS BONUS is awarded to the Breeder of STAGBI registered British Bred (conceived and born in England, Scotland or Wales) winners of nominated Races. The nominated races change from year to year and are chosen by the Directors of STAGBI. Each year nominated races will included a 2yo Race, 3yo Race, 4yo Race and Open Races. The breeders will receive their awards at the end of the year. Congratulations to those who have bred the winners, good luck to those in the up and coming races.

STAGBI MEMBERSHIP

To benefit from the STAGBI awards you do need to be a current STAGBI membership. Membership is due on the 1st April and is available at £10 per year or you can take advantage of the offer of GOLD MEMBERSHIP which is £40 for 5 years

STALLION LICENSING 2017

Over the past few years the process of stallion licensing has become more structured. Currently, as per STAGBI Rules and Regulations an **application to register a stallion for stud duties should be submitted to STAGBI prior to the stallion being used for stud duties.**

An application to register a stallion for stud duties will only be considered by STAGBI if the following criteria are fulfilled:

- The stallion must be registered as a Full Bred Standardbred with STAGBI
- The stallion must have a DNA profile on record and be parentally verified by DNA analysis to his sire and dam.
- The stallion must be 3 (three) years of age or older
- The stallion must be examined by a Veterinary Surgeon and confirmed as suitable for stud duties

PLEASE NOTE: As of 1 April 2017, in addition to fulfilling the above criteria: the horse must have a performance record with a recognised organisation OR his sire must hold a record of 1.55.0 or faster in North America/Southern Hemisphere or 2.00 or in UK/Ireland.

The registration of a stallion for stud duties and the issuing of a Stallion Licence, is subject to the approval of STAGBI. If the application to register a stallion for stud duties is successful and a Stallion Licence is Issued, the Stallion will be included on STAGBI's List of Licenced Stallions and Graded accordingly.

STAGBI have now worked on the Grading of stallions and every Licenced Stallion on STAGBI's active list will now be Graded as Grade A, B or C. The Stallion will be graded according to STAGBI's Stallion Grading Criteria as follows, noting that a Stallions Grade change during the course of time.

Grade A Stallions will have an official record of 1:55.0 or faster (North America/Southern Hemisphere) **or** 2:00.0 or faster (UK/Ireland) **AND** progeny who have won

Grade B Stallions will have an official record of 1:55.0 or faster (North America/Southern Hemisphere) or 2:00.0 or faster (UK/Ireland) **OR** progeny who have won

Grade C Stallions have neither a record of 1:55.0 or faster (North America/Southern Hemisphere) or 2:00.0 or faster (UK/Ireland) NOR any winning progeny.

Stallion Grades will be reviewed annually and stallions may be upgraded if the criteria is fulfilled or at the discretion of the Directors of STAGBI.
